Submit one form for each book you are requesting and fill out this form completely, any missing information may delay the delivery of your textbook.

Please submit your requests early as possible because it could take up to 2 weeks to receive files from the publishers or permission to create an accessible copy by cutting and scanning your copy of the book.

If you are receiving PDF files of your books, you will need to present proof of purchase for your books, this can be the books themselves, or a copy of the receipt when you pick up the files. In some cases, I will need to cut and scan your copy of the book to create an accessible copy therefore, you may want to consider this when deciding to rent or borrow a textbook.
