

CastleBranch (myCB) Process for Health Sciences Program Students

In order to be considered a health sciences program student you must be registered/enrolled into a health sciences program course number having one of the following prefixes:

| Course Nbr Prefix | Heath Sciences Program |

There is a separate CastleBranch (myCB) process for MassBay students enrolled into non-health sciences program courses such as Automotive, Humanities, Social Sciences & Professional Studies, and STEM including STEM labs. If you are enrolled into one of these program courses, you should direct your MassBay immunization/ CastleBranch inquiry to Student Development at studentdevelopment@massbay.edu.

To better serve our health sciences program student students, MassBay Community College has partnered since 2013 with a third-party company named is CastleBranch (myCB) to manage our health sciences students' health and safety compliance online. CastleBranch is a leading provider of immunization record tracking solutions for higher education. It allows MassBay to meet the needs of the health sciences program clinical agencies and/or accrediting bodies' clinical requirements.

Health Program students will be provided with a four-character program-specific code to use for the initial access to create their "myCB" accounts. These codes are provided at the Health Sciences program new student orientations and will also be confirmed via email on or before class registration. Additionally, a unique PIN will be assigned allowing for the student to order their Castle Branch account after registering into a health sciences program class.
