### **Governor Baker Stay-at-home Order Extended**

Today, Gov. Baker announced Massachusetts has extended the order for the closure of non-essential businesses and stay-at-home order to May 4, 2020. This order also limits all gatherings to 10 people or less, in an on-going effort to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and enforce social distancing. Because of this, MassBay will continue to operate remotely and all Spring 2020 courses will remain in an online or remote format.
