DAMAGE APPRAISAL

AND APPRENTICESHIP COURSE

AT MASSBAY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Take the first steps to becoming an Auto Damage Appraiser in Massachusetts through MassBay's Damage Appraiser's and Apprenticeship courses; approved by the Massachusetts Division of Insurance. The Certified Damage Appraiser's course is designed for claims professionals, auto body technicians and others. Students will be trained for Part I of the Massachusetts Automobile Damage Appraisers License Examination. The course includes in-depth discussion of insurance regulations, policy arbitration, and work completion forms, use of Flat Rate Manuals, collision diagnosis, cost estimation and preparation of written estimates.

MASS STATE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS: MOTOR VEHICLE DAMAGE APPRAISER

A work experience letter from a licensed Massachusetts appraiser with whom you have worked for a period of at least three (3) months. This letter must be signed by the appraiser and his seal affixed.(MassBay's two courses provide the necessary 3 months of work experience)

A copy of certification received from a Board approved damage appraiser course.(MassBay's courses are approved by the State Board.) PLEASE NOTE: Two years practical work experience writing appraisals, may be substituted for the required course work.

If you have had any convictions, a transcript from the courts identifying the offense(s) and a letter of explanation should be included.
