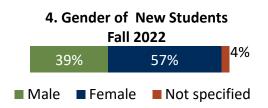

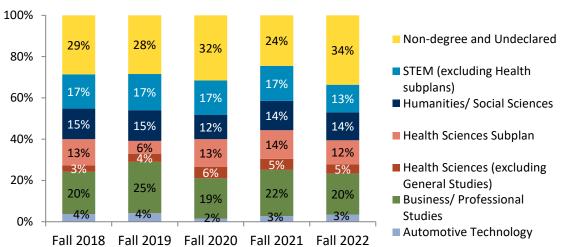

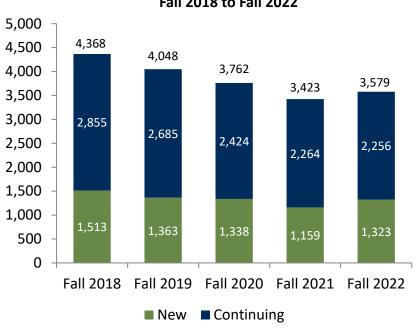

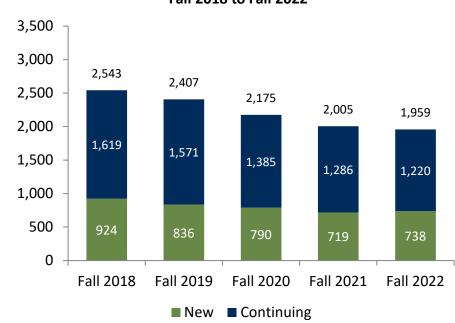




8. New, Continuing and Total Enrollment Fall 2018 to Fall 2022



# 9. New, Continuing and Total FTE Fall 2018 to Fall 2022

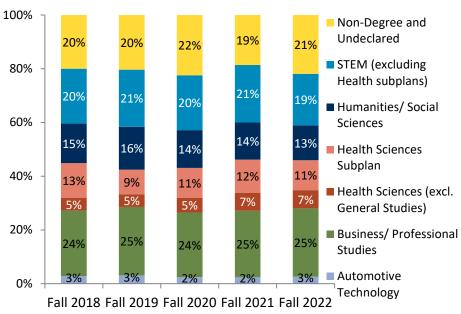

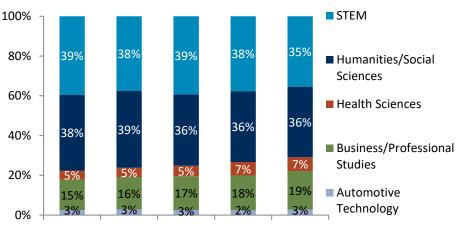

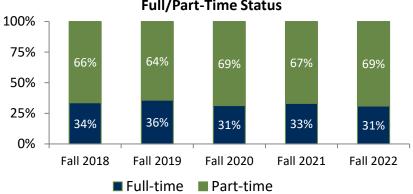
### 13. Distribution of Credits Sold\* by Academic Division



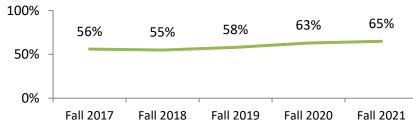

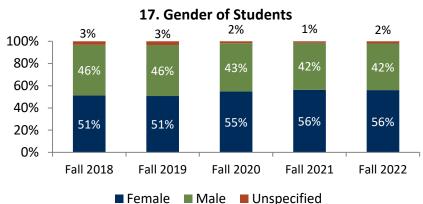




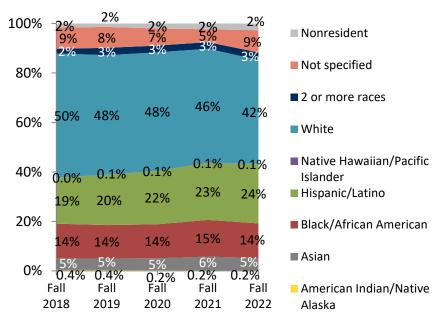


# 16. Percentage of First-Time Degree/Certificate Seeking Students Receiving Financial Aid





### 15. Race/Ethnicity of Students Fall 2018 to Fall 2022

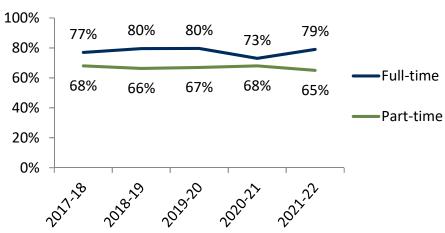

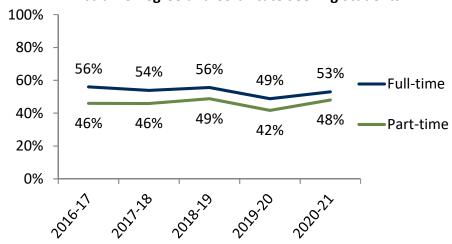

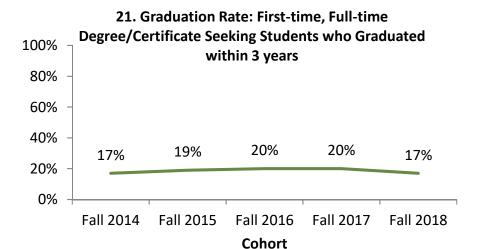


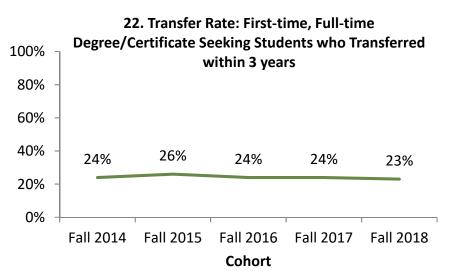
19. Fall to Spring Retention Rate: First-time Degree and Certificate Seeking Students



20. Fall to Fall Retention Rate: First-time Degree and Certificate Seeking Students

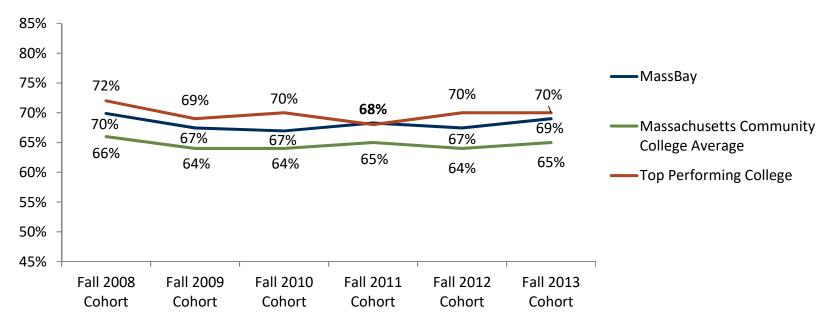








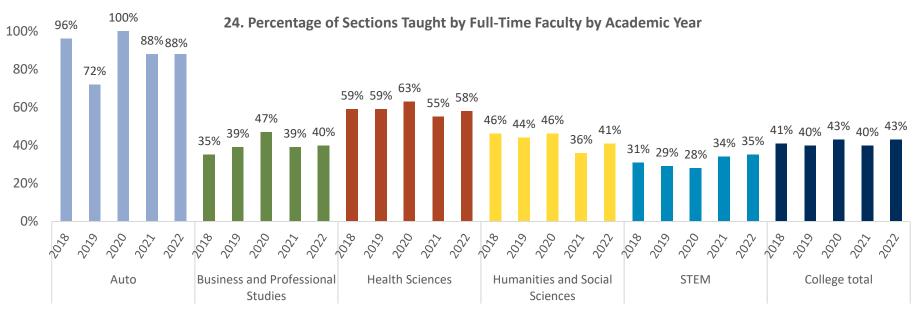
# 23. Six-Year Comprehensive Student Success Rate (Voluntary Framework for Accountability)

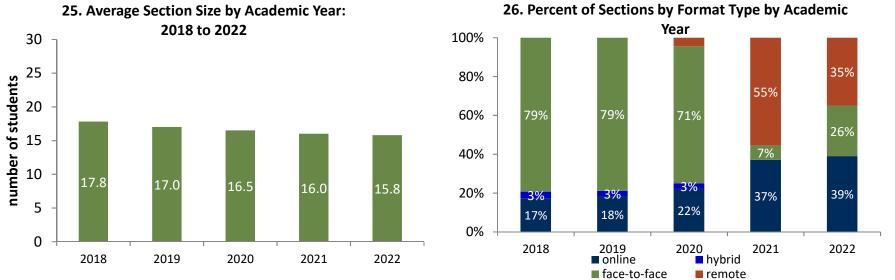


This metric includes in the cohort all new (first-time and transfer students), full and part-time, degree and certificate seeking students, and non-degree students who earned at least twelve credits during their first two academic years. Students are counted with a successful outcome if they, within six years, earn a degree or certificate, transfer to a two or four-year school, attain at least 30 credits and/or are still enrolled.

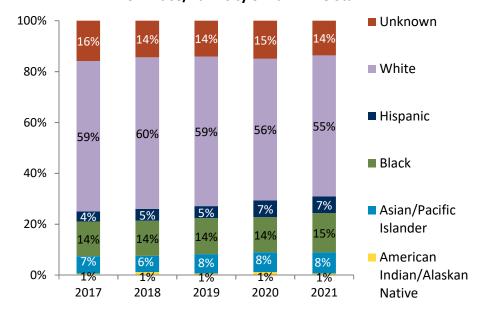




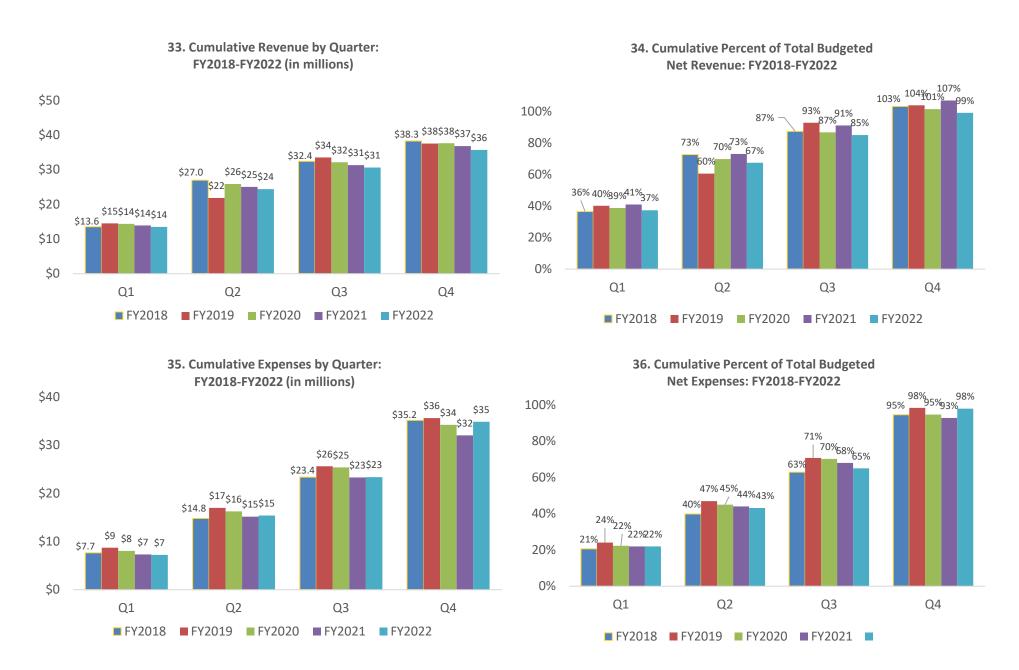
31. Gender of Full-Time Staff



### 32. Race/Ethnicity of Full-Time Staff

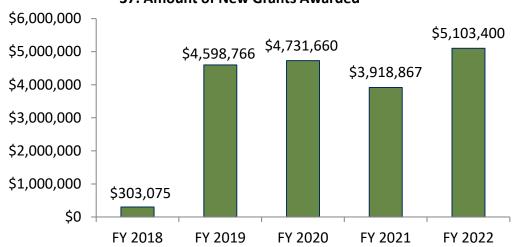
