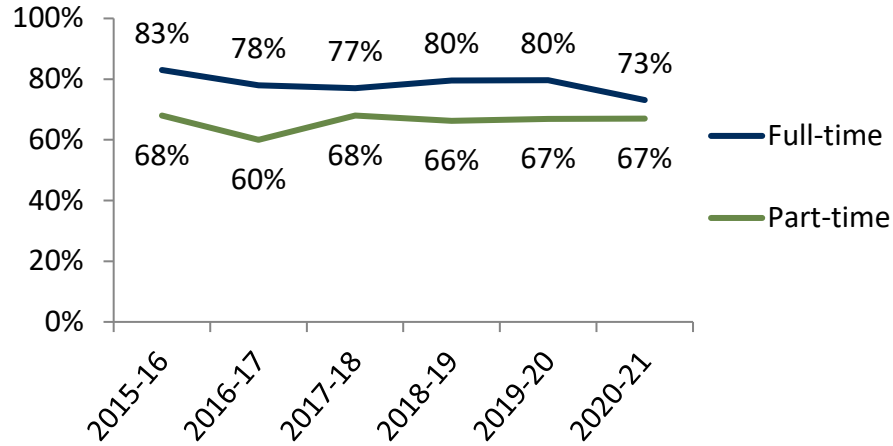
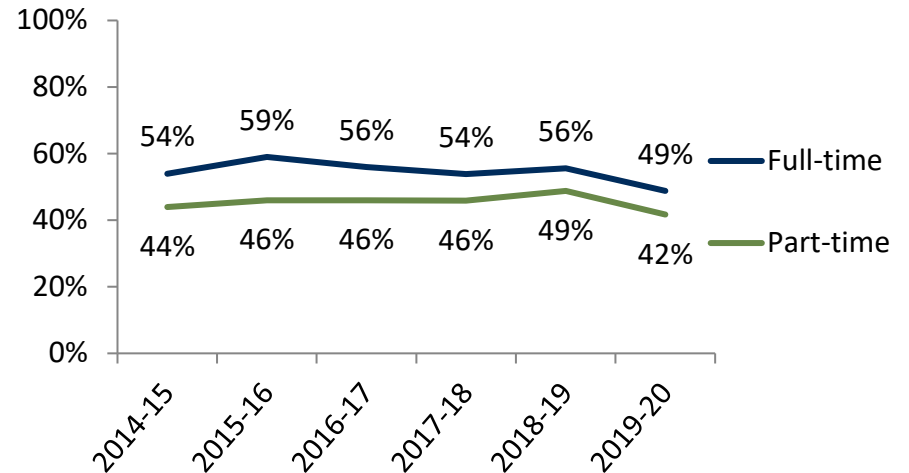


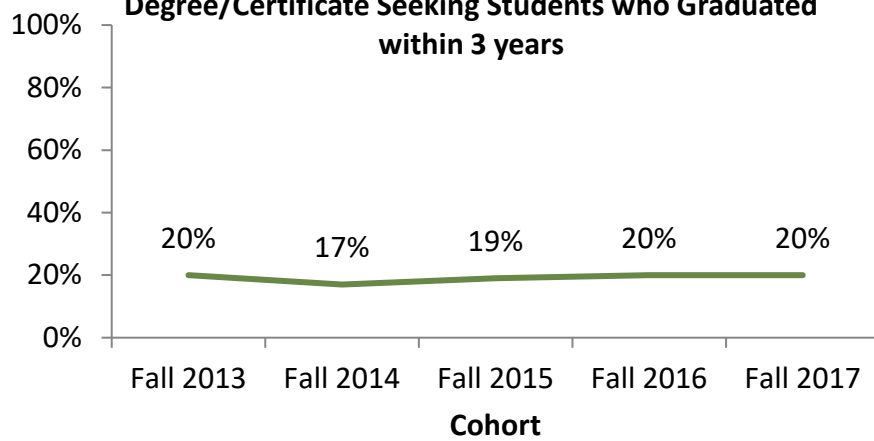
**Fall to Spring Retention Rate:
First-time Degree and Certificate Seeking Students**



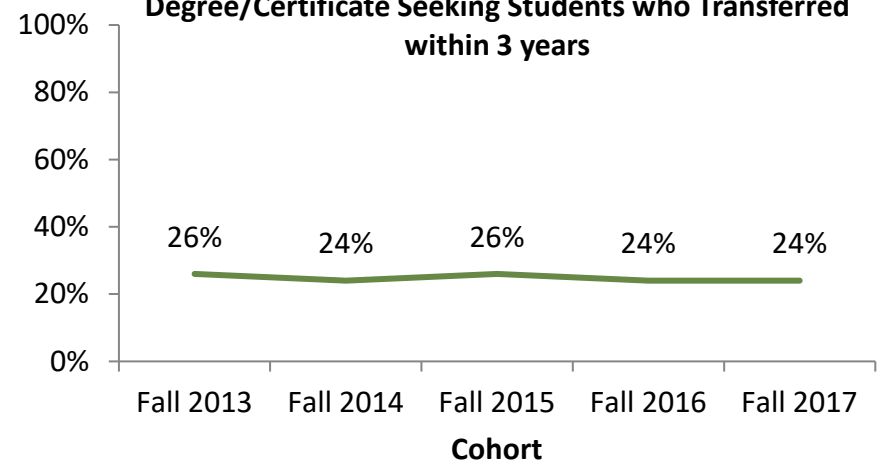
**Fall to Fall Retention Rate:
First-time Degree and Certificate Seeking Students**



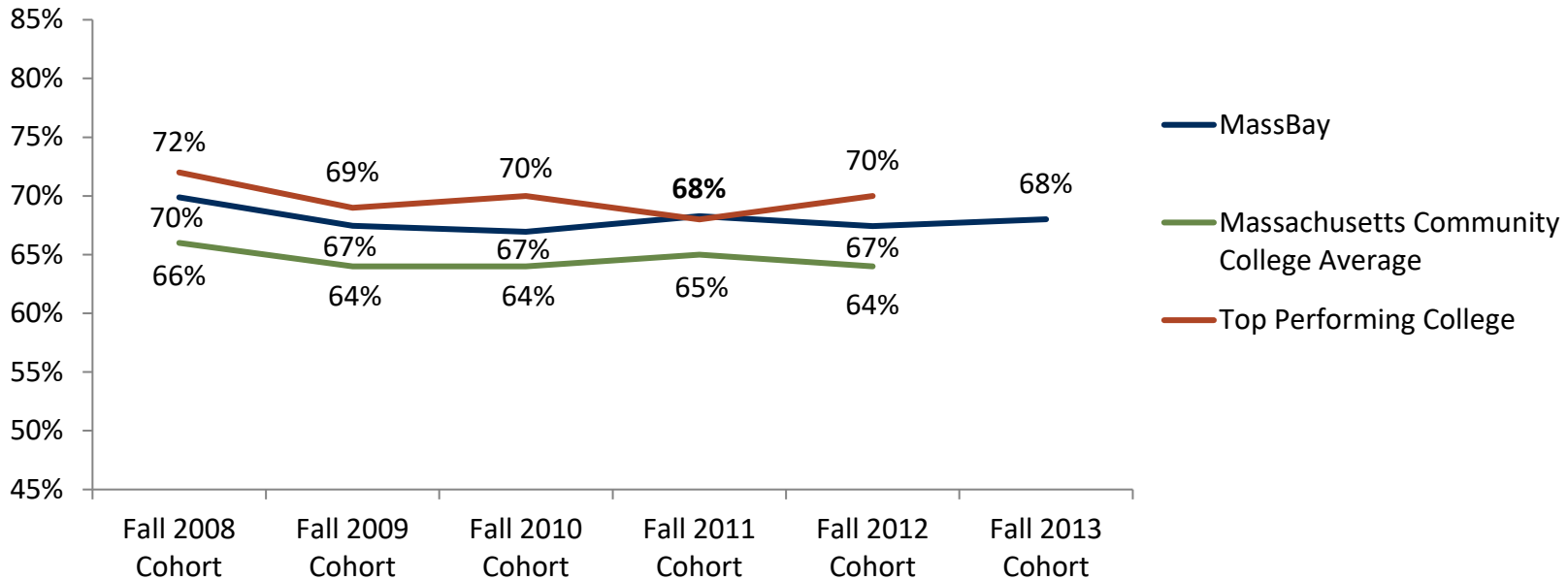
**Graduation Rate: First-time, Full-time

This metric includes in the cohort all new (first-time and transfer students), full and part-time, degree and certificate seeking students, and non-degree students who earned at least twelve credits during their first two academic years. Students are counted with a successful outcome if they, within six years, earn a degree or certificate, transfer to a two or four-year school, attain at least 30 credits and/or are still enrolled.

Note: Data for the Fall 2008 through Fall 2010 cohorts and the Fall 2012 cohort comes from DHE's Student Success & Completion Performance Dashboard. For the Fall 2011 cohort, the data point on the Massachusetts community college average comes from DHE and the Office of Institutional Research provided the data points on MassBay and the top performing college. For the Fall 2013 cohort, the data on MassBay was provided by the Office of Institutional Research; however, the DHE data is not yet available.
