

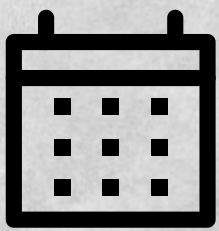

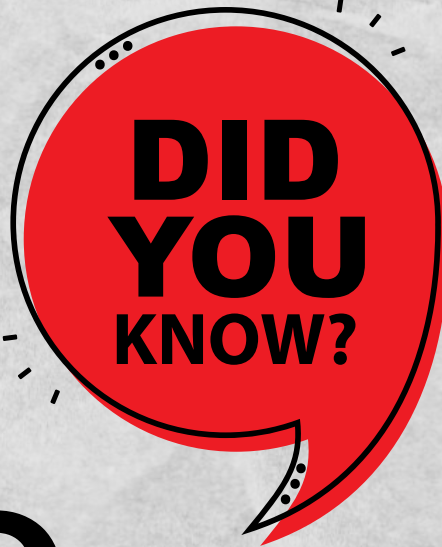


It is celebrated
