Job opportunities for Legal Studies graduates are growing rapidly.

The Massachusetts Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development projects an 18% growth in paralegal jobs between 2012 and 2022. In fact, the Boston-Cambridge-Quincy metro area ranks in the top 10 nationally for paralegal employment.

There are multiple career paths for criminal justice majors from police, security, and correction officers to courtroom positions such as bailiffs, clerks, and reporters to crime scene investigator positions, and more. The Bureau of Labor Statistics projects 7% growth for all of these occupations between 2016 and 2026.

Legal Studies Academy Associate Degree Options

Associate degree programs can be completed in two years of full-time study and will prepare you to either seek employment in the field or enter a four-year college in your junior year.

Criminal Justice

This program combines professional coursework (Introduction to Criminal Justice, Criminal Law and Procedures, Juvenile Offenders), with a broad background in liberal arts to ensure the seamless transfer of credits toward a four-year degree. The program is approved as a Police Career Incentive Program by the Massachusetts Board of Higher Education.

Paralegal Studies

This program will train you to prepare and draft legal documents, research legal issues, interview clients and witnesses, and provide procedural assistance in law-related matters. A hands-on experience working in a law firm is included in the curriculum. Our paralegal studies classes are all online, providing students with the opportunity to choose their schedule.



Legal Studies Academy Certificate Program Options

Certificate programs focus on building specific skills without requiring the general academic coursework required for an associate degree. Certificates take less than two years to complete

Paralegal Studies

This program provides a solid foundation in all aspects of the field including litigation, legal research, and writing. Electives enable you to build knowledge in specialty areas such as real estate, family law, business law and trusts, and estate planning. This program is offered completely online to provide students with a flexible learning schedule.
